DICE BAG KNITTING PATTERN

MATERIALS

- ½ skein Lily's Sugar & Cream yarn, any color
- yarn needle
- US 4 (3.5mm) double-pointed needles
- US 4 (3.5 mm) circular needles, 16-inches long**
- stitch marker**
- measuring tape
- scissors

GAUGE

Not important

FINISHED SIZE

Approx. 7 wide x 8 in long

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cast on 60 stitches on 3 or 4 DPNs, whichever is preferred.
- 2. Join in the round.
- 3. Knit all stitches, keeping track of which DPN holds the first stitch.
- 4. Continue knitting in the round until the stitches have grown enough to be transferred to circular needles.**
- 5. Knit all stitches until work measures 8-inches from the first row.
- 6. Use Kitchener Stitch to bind off.
- 7. For the drawstring, cut a piece of yarn about 2 feet long. Work a loose running stitch around the bag, about 1 inch from the top. Tie the ends of the yarn. Pull tightly to close bag.
- **Circular needles *may* be used, but are not required. I find them easier, so once I get 2-3 rows in, I transfer my stitches to circs. To do this, simply work them over to the circs by knitting. If you choose to stick with DPNs, the stitch marker is not required.
